Quick Scam Prevention Checklist

- Pause. Scammers use urgency—breathe and verify.
- Never pay with gift cards, crypto, or wire for 'urgent fees.'
- Verify the sender: check the full email/number & spelling.
- Don't click links—type the site or use a saved bookmark.
- Call back using a number from the official website.
- Enable multi-factor authentication (MFA) on accounts.
- Use strong, unique passwords and a password manager.
- Update phone & apps; turn on automatic updates.
- Set bank/credit alerts for charges, transfers, logins.
- Report scams: FTC, your bank/card, and Human Reclassified.
