The Mission in Norwalk

The Human Reclassified Foundation is currently deployed in Norwalk, CA, to neutralize the threat of AI-enabled exploitation. We provide senior citizens and local youth with the psychological and technical tools to identify deepfakes, voice-clones, and sophisticated SMS fraud.

Key Activities (March 2026):

- **Guardian Protocol Workshops:** Interactive sessions held at the Norwalk Senior Center, teaching seniors how to use "Human-in-the-Loop" verification before responding to urgent digital requests.
- **NLMUSD Safety Integration:** Analyzing school district communication patterns to help families distinguish between official alerts and malicious impersonations.
- **Immersive Education:** Utilizing the "Scamocalypse" curriculum to gamify cybersecurity, making complex AI threats understandable and manageable for non-technical users.
